It has been 16 years since the death of French academic Lisette Nigot. As depicted in Janine Hosking's beautiful documentary '[Mademoiselle & the Doctor](#)' Lisette died because she was turning 80. '*80 is the time to die*' as she said.

In 2017, Australian couple & long time **Exit Members Beverley & Athol Whiston** have followed in the amazing footsteps of Lisette Nigot.

As Athol explains it '*we believe at 80 we have had a great life and we have lived long enough*'.


Married for over 50 years, when explaining why they chose to go together, Beverley says: '*why would I want to leave the other part of me behind? It's not possible, I can't do that, we are one*'.

Remembering Professor David Goodall

It is now a week since 104 year old Professor David Goodall died at the Life Circle - Eternal Spirit Clinic in Basel Switzerland.

News of his death is too vast to list here although Exit appreciates the work of [CNN](#) and [Associated Press](#) in telling David's story.

During his very long life, London-born David, was to become one of Australia's leading scientists. David's PhD was in the field of tomatoes. His post-retirement work concerned the editing of 30 volumes of the series 'Ecosystems of the World'.

As a man committed to science and rational thought, it is perhaps not surprising that Professor Goodall had strong opinions about the future of the planet.

In his final days he was a daily visitor to the Botanic Gardens at the University of Basel. In speaking to Dr Philip Nitschke and Ruedi Habegger in his last week, he said he was keen share his views.
